ACCOMODATION AND TRAVEL

If you are arriving in New Zealand prior to the start of school, here are a selection of hostels and motels for you to look at in both Auckland and in Cambridge.

ACCOMODATION

Auckland City

Albert Park Backpackers: www.alberpark.co.nz

Open 24 / 7, near buses, cafes, shops, movie theatres etc. Also provides cable TV, Internet access, entertainment area and a female only dorm

Base ACB: www.stayatbase.com

Located in the heart of Auckland city near the central transport hub, shops, cafes, movie theatres. Base ACB has a 24-hour reception and high-speed Internet.

Kiwi International Queen Street Hostel: www.kiwihotel.co.nz

24-hour reception, a common room, laundry and pool table are just a few of the facilities this hostel provides. It is placed in the heart of the city, with cafes, shops and movie theatres nearby.

Aspen House Hotel: www.aspenhouse.co.nz

Aspen House Hotel combines the best of hotel and B&B style budget accommodation. Situated beside a park in the heart of Auckland City, the room rates include a buffet continental breakfast.

Cambridge

Number 1 Motels on Victoria: www.no1motels.co.nz

A new international motor lodge providing separate kitchen and dining room, a brassiere and Internet access.

Cambrian Lodge Motel: www.cambrianlodge.co.nz

Cambrian Lodge Motel is only 4 minutes walk to the town centre where there are many cafes and restaurants. The motel also provides Sky TV, swimming pool, private spa

Captains Quarters Motor Inn: www.captainsquartersmotorinn.co.nz

Located in a very quiet situation; guest laundry, Sky TV, cooked and continental breakfasts are some of the services provided.

TRAVEL

There is a shuttle service from Auckland airport to any one of the Auckland hostels mentioned above. The charge is \$22NZD per person or \$28NZD (cost subject to change) for two people travelling together. The shuttle will drop you off at the front door of your accommodation.

If you are staying in Auckland for a few days before school commences, the best way to get to Cambridge is on an Intercity coach. The pick up point is:

If you choose to travel by bus to Cambridge on the day school starts, we will pick you up from the Cambridge bus stop. Ensure you let our Registrar know of your bus arrival time so we can make arrangements to collect you from the bus stop.

Shuttle bus

A shuttle bus is the best option if you are flying in on the day school starts. If you would like, you can contact the Registrar registrar@capernwray.org.nz who will make the booking arrangements with the shuttle bus company on your behalf.

Please ensure that you give the Registrar approximately **10 days** advance notice of your shuttle bus needs. The shuttle bus needs to be booked for each student.

Shuttle buses are located outside the Arrivals Lounge at Auckland International Airport, with free phones located inside the arrival area to book one, should none be available.
